Thanks to the commitment and compassion of our many supporters, partners, volunteers, and staff, we were able to provide over 16,000 older adults and their **caregivers** with innovative services focused on supporting independence. empowering caregivers, connecting community, and serving compassionately. We could not have done this without you!

People tell us that they choose Senior Community Services (SCS) because they trust us, we're affordable, or they have physical challenges keeping up their home like they used to. As one client stated, 'I'm able to stay in my home because of you.'

Some people aren't sure if mom or dad should stay at home or if they need more support. These decisions are tough. We often hear how helpful it can be to have a neutral, impartial professional to help with these important discussions. Senior Community Services provides social workers who assess these situations and help families navigate the options, taking stress off the caregivers.

Now think about how technology can be challenging even when you understand it. We know that having the ability and education to navigate newer technologies has become a necessity to fully participate in society. And seniors unfamiliar with or without access to technology are more isolated than ever.

We expanded our technology programs in 2022 in partnership with our senior centers and in 2023 we will continue to reach out to underserved populations and communities that may have economic challenges on top of language barriers to provide them with the tech tools and access to the internet that they need.


